
Dear Ms. Goldberg:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter of April 30, 1975, and to confirm the telephone conversation with our Transportation Specialist John M. Harar on Monday, May 5, 1975, informing you as to my inability and that of Mr. William F. Sibbald, Jr., Chief, Section of Motor Carriers, to attend the meeting scheduled for Wednesday, May 7, 1975, concerning the parking situation in the vicinity of The Shoreham North.

As you were informed, any illegal parking or possible nuisances related thereto are within the jurisdiction of the local enforcement authorities. Our involvement in handling this matter with carriers subject to our jurisdiction was to provide whatever assistance possible toward amicable solution. In response to our notice, Continental Trailways notified all General Managers of the various other Continental and Trailways' carriers to instruct their operators in the manner of loading and unloading customers at the Shoreham. Associated Transport took similar action in notifying its drivers concerning this situation. D. C. Transit System, Inc., advised that while their vehicles are seldom in the involved area, they are instructing their drivers concerning this complaint.
