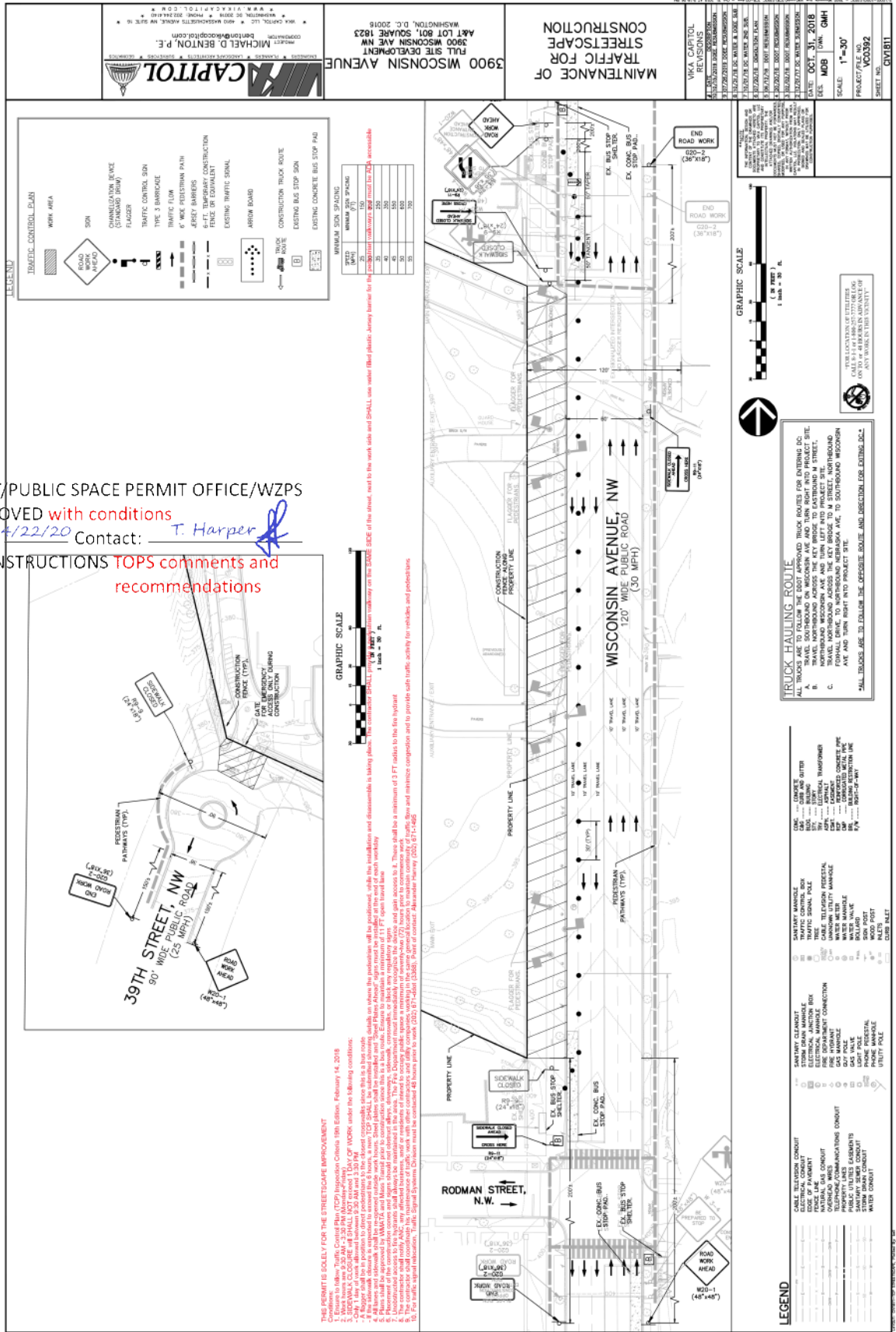

THIS PERMIT IS SOLELY FOR THE STREETScape IMPROVEMENT

1. Permit to Allow Traffic Control Plan (TCP) Inspection Criteria 19th Edition, February 14, 2018

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3. SIGNAGE CLOSURE AT 39TH STREET TO BE MAINTAINED FOR THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT

4. All work shall be completed within the 8 hour window. Street closures shall be maintained for the duration of the project.

5. All work shall be approved by WMA/TK and filed. Road prior to construction shall always be maintained in the area. The Department shall immediately investigate the device and gate access to it. These shall be the minimum of 3 FT radius to the fire hydrant.

6. The contractor shall coordinate the transportation of traffic with other contractors and utility companies in the same geographic area to maintain continuity of traffic flow and minimize congestion and to provide safe traffic activity for vehicles and pedestrians.

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
