To the Committee:

This letter regards public space application No. 342460, submitted by Nash-Roadside 3900 Wisconsin LLC.

The application provides details of plans for work to be done in public space in conjunction with the City Ridge development at 3900 Wisconsin Ave. NW. Work includes installing streetlights, moving a bus stop, planting trees and other landscaping, building sidewalks and more.

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3C solicited resident input. One key concern arose: Residents worry that moving the bus stop to the south side of Rodman Street will prompt WMATA to eliminate the bus stop because of its proximity to a bus stop at Porter Street. We realize this is out of the jurisdiction of the Public Space Committee but wish to note the concern for the record, so that it can be part of any future communications between the Public Space Committee, Roadside and WMATA.

ANC3C voted unanimously on June 10, 2020, to support the application, on the condition that the committee notes in the record residents' concern about losing the bus stop.
