Establishment of Quorum:

The Chair, Commissioner Finley, called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. and announced there was a quorum. Commissioners Boucher and Reba were absent.

Approval of Agenda:

Commissioner Pagats moved approval of the amended agenda. The agenda was adopted by voice vote.

Community Forum: None

Consent Calendar: Commissioner Pagats made a motion to approve the consent calendar, which included a Resolution regarding Ward 3 Mutual Aid Grant. The motion was approved by voice vote.

Commission Business:

- 1. Consideration of a Resolution in Support of Concept C for DDOT options on Connecticut Avenue***

Commissioner Siddiqui read and moved the resolution.

Commissioner MacWood moved a friendly amendment. Commissioners Siddiqui and Reba accepted.

Commissioner MacWood moved an additional friendly amendment. Commissioner Siddiqui did not accept the friendly amendment. Commissioner MacWood then moved another amendment to the resolution. Commissioner Reba accepted; however, Commissioner Siddiqui did not accept this amendment as well. Principal Jacqueline Anderson from John Eaton Elementary School spoke in support of the amendment and expressed her concerns with DDOT's deadline/timeline for comments. Commissioner Siddiqui decided to accept Commissioner MacWood's (whereas/resolve) amendments.

Members of the community spoke on the resolution.

Commissioner Reba moved another friendly amendment. Commissioner Siddiqui accepted. The motion was approved by voice vote.

2. *Consideration of a Resolution regarding a Board of Zoning Application for Special Exception for WIS (Case No. 20458)*

3. *Consideration of a Resolution regarding a Historic Preservation Review Board application for 3056 Porter Street (HPA 21-267) to add a two-story addition to the rear and replace garage doors with windows in the front*

Commissioner Siddiqui read and moved the resolution. The motion was approved by voice vote.
