3. SMD Reports:

- **(3C01) Commissioner Reba: A)** On June 30th the Smithsonian approved an increase in the amount of visitors the Smithsonian's National Zoo can admit daily, and an increase in their building capacity. **B)** As of July 1st - DPW started ticketing and booting all vehicles. **C)** As of July 18th, METRO will expand train service to midnight, seven days a week. **D)** DDOT will temporarily close Beach Drive NW between the Shoreham Drive NW and Tilden Street NW between the hours of 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM from July 12 through December 20, 2021, weather permitting.
- **(3C02) Commissioner Fink:** Absent
- **(3C03) Commissioner Pagats:** WMATA tunnel pilot project kicked off and will be single tracking until the end of August, sidewalks will also be torn up.
- **(3C04) Commissioner Finley: A)** The WMATA Tunnel ventilation project on the redline from Dupont to Van Ness has begun. During this period, the Cleveland Park METRO will be closed. **B)** The ANC-Transparency Committee will be meeting on Thursday, 8/19.

- **(3C05) Commissioner Siddiqui:** A) Hearst Park & Pool project has begun to make progress, but there continues to be a lack of transparency. B) ParkDC launched a new Visitor Parking Pass program online.
