**ANC3C Resolution 2021-11**  
**Regarding Safe, Sustainable, and Equitable Transportation Committee**

WHEREAS, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3C (ANC 3C or Commission) is committed to safe, sustainable, and equitable transportation infrastructure for all community members, including pedestrians, bicyclists, users of mass transit, motorists, emergency responders, and persons of all ages and abilities;

WHEREAS, ANC 3C is committed to the safety of all people who live and visit its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, ANC 3C is committed to the sustainability of the environment through transforming its transportation infrastructure;

WHEREAS, ANC 3C is committed to the sustainability of the businesses by establishing transportation infrastructure that makes our businesses thrive and our neighborhood vibrant;

WHEREAS, ANC 3C is committed to an equitable neighborhood for all, which includes equitable transportation infrastructure for the residents and visitors to our community; and

WHEREAS, ANC 3C has a number of transportation issues it has to engage the community on, including the Connecticut Avenue streetscape, drainage, and redesign; the service lane on Connecticut Ave NW between Macomb St. NW and Ordway St. NW; and general engagement on the safety and sustainability of transportation issues throughout the neighborhood.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3C establishes a Safe and Sustainable Transportation Committee as a standing committee;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Safe and Sustainable Transportation Committee is tasked with the following:

- Engaging the community to get input and drive consensus towards decisions about transportation infrastructure;
- Drafting recommendations to the Commission for advocacy of transportation issues;
- Serving as a bridge between the community and Commission to promote engagement and transparency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Sauleh Siddiqui, Commissioner for SMD 3C05, shall be the Chair of the Safe and Sustainable Transportation Committee of ANC 3C for the Commission Year 2021;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Committee Chair shall appoint, with the approval of the Commission, additional members of the Committee;

Be It Resolved that the ANC authorizes the Chair and the Commissioners for 3C01, 3C04, and 3C05 to represent the Commission on this matter.
