ANC3C Resolution 2022-CONSENT
Requesting Installation of Speed Humps on the 2900 and 3000 Blocks of
Cortland Place NW

Whereas, the 2900 and 3000 blocks of Cortland Place NW are located between Connecticut Avenue NW and 34th Street NW and are designated as “Local” by the District Department of Transportation (DDOT); and

Whereas, traffic on these blocks is exacerbated due to the road being an offshoot of highly trafficked Connecticut Ave NW and fast-moving 34th Street NW; and

Whereas, the affected area raises numerous safety concerns within a residential area, including speeding and aggressive driving; and

Whereas, there is a playground that is used extensively by small children and their guardians on the 2900 and 3000 Blocks of Cortland Place NW; and

Whereas, although DDOT no longer requires written petitions for speed hump requests, 12 residents (constituting 75% of the residents of the 2900 Block of Cortland Place NW) have expressed support by signing a written Petition in in favor of this traffic study to install speed humps; and

Whereas, the 3000 Block of Cortland Place, like the 2900 Block of Cortland Place, is adjacent to a playground and is a continuous street where speeding also occurs; and

Whereas, the local residents have also submitted a 311 request with Service Number 21-00552283; and

Whereas, the affected area is residential with significant pedestrian and bicycle traffic, including children and seniors, who are more vulnerable to traffic injuries and fatalities.

Be It Resolved that ANC 3C calls on DDOT to timely collect data and complete its review of the outstanding requests related to traffic safety issues along the 2900 and 3000 Blocks of Cortland Place NW.

Be it further Resolved that ANC 3C recognizes the community support for speed humps along the 2900 and 3000 Blocks of Cortland Place NW and calls on DDOT to promptly install speed humps along this street.

Be It Resolved that the ANC authorizes the Chair and the Commissioner for 3C08 to represent the Commission on this matter.
