ANC3C Resolution 2022-CONSENT
**Regarding Woodley Park Participation in 2022 Art All Night (Saturday,
September 24, 2022)**

WHEREAS the 2022 Art All Night (“the Event”) is a festival that celebrates visual and performing arts in Washington DC, including painting, photography, sculpture, crafts, fashion, music, dance, theater, film, and poetry. The festival takes place in 16 different Main Street corridors and is held in both indoor and outdoor public and private spaces, including businesses;

WHEREAS the Event is presented by Mayor Muriel Bowser in partnership with Anacostia BID, Destination Congress Heights, Eastern Market Main Street, Historic Dupont Circle Main Streets, H Street Main Street, Minnesota Avenue Main Street, Pennsylvania Ave East Main Street, North Capitol Street Main Street, Shaw Main Streets, Tenleytown Main Street, The Parks Main Street, Uptown Main Street, Ward 7 Business Partnership, Georgetown Main Street, Van Ness Main Street, Upper Georgia Avenue Main Street with support from the DC Commission on the Arts & Humanities and the Department of Small and Local Business Development;

WHEREAS Saturday September 24, 2022 will be Woodley Park’s first participation in the Event. To date, 16 neighborhoods were part of the last city-wide Event pre-pandemic. This year’s Event is likely to bring 1,000-2,000 visitors to Woodley Park and participation is intended to reinforce Woodley Park as a lively destination for neighbors and visitors alike;

WHEREAS the current overview of the Event includes:

- Start in the North Corridor around 1 PM with a photography workshop for +/- 50 kids at the National Zoo. The pictures will be judged by photographers from the Stanford Gallery, Focus on the Story, and, likely, the National Press Club.
- Arts market in the South Corridor from 11:00 AM to 6:00 PM in the same vein as the recent Father’s Day market.
- Following the market, hope to use projection mapping to animate the Perry Lions at either side of the entrance to the bridge (financing dependent). There will be roaming music and individual businesses will host related events.

WHEREAS Woodley Park Main Street has raised \$20,000 from the City to support the Event and welcome contributions large and small from donors/businesses;

WHEREAS Woodley Park restaurants wishing to participate by hosting music will need to acquire a temporary/permanent music endorsement from ABRA;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3C supports Woodley Park Main Street's participation in the 2022 Event;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3C calls on ABRA, DDOT, DCRA and any other District Agencies that may have jurisdiction over permitting matters to approve all applications associated with the Event;

BE IT RESOLVED the Commission authorizes the Chair and the Commissioners for 3C01, 3C02 and 3C03 to represent the Commission on this matter.
