ANC3C Resolution 2022-023
Resolution Regarding The Endangered Animals Art Project

WHEREAS The Capitol Hill Alphabet Animal Art Project (Alphabet Animals) is a community-focused public art project that promotes livability, walkability, and delight in the Southeast Quadrant of Washington, DC;

WHEREAS in 2014, 10 sculptures were successfully installed through a pilot partnership with District Department of Transportation (DDOT), and in 2020, another 10 joined the menagerie through a grant from the DC Commission on the Arts & Humanities (DCCA);

WHEREAS The Endangered Animals Project will expand on the Alphabet Animals, adding 10 new sculptures along the Connecticut Avenue NW corridor between Woodley Park and Cleveland Park;

WHEREAS through the Capitol Hill Arts Workshop (CHAW) - Cleveland Park Main Street (CPMS) - Woodley Park Main Street (WPMS) Partnership, this expansion of the project will provide artistic touchpoints for local businesses as well as residents, further strengthening the connection of creativity with a flourishing neighborhood;

WHEREAS The Alphabet Animals encourage residents, business owners, artists, makers, and passersby to explore the inter-connectivity of community through the entry point of unexpected encounters with high-quality art in public spaces-and this new expansion to Endangered Animals adds an important new focus on protecting the wild and wonderful world around us;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3C expresses its support for the CHAW-CPMS-WPMS Partnership's participation in expanding the Endangered Animals Project along the Connecticut Avenue NW corridor;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3C expresses its support for CHAW-CPMS-WPMS Partnership's application for a Public Arts Building Communities grant from the DCCA;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission authorizes the Chair and the Commissioners for 3C03, and 3C05 to represent the Commission on this matter.
