ANC3C Resolution 2023-010

Resolution to Support the Endangered Animals Art Project Regarding by Providing a Grant for \$5,000 to the Capitol Hill Arts Workshop, the Cleveland Park Main Street, and the Woodley Park Main Street (CHAW-CPMS-WPMS Partnership)

WHEREAS The Endangered Animals Project has been proposed by a partnership of the Capitol Hill Arts Workshop, the Cleveland Park Main Street, and the Woodley Park Main Sstreet (CHAW-CPMS-WPMS Partnership) to provide artistic touch points for local businesses, residents and visitors to our community;

WHEREAS the Endangered Animals Project will install 10 new sculptures along the Connecticut Avenue NW corridor between Woodley Park and Cleveland Park;

WHEREAS the Endangered Animals Project is meant to encourage residents, business owners, artists, makers, and passersby to explore the inter-connectivity of community through the entry point of unexpected encounters with high-quality art in public spaces-and bring attention to Endangered Animals;

WHEREAS this project is modeled on the successful Capitol Hill Alphabet Animal Art Project (Alphabet Animals), a community-focused public art project that promotes livability, walkability, and delight in the Southeast Quadrant of Washington, DC;

WHEREAS ANC 3C has previously expressed support for the project (ANC3C Resolution 2022-023: Resolution Regarding The Endangered Animals Art Project, 13 December 2022);

WHEREAS ANC 3C supports CHAW-CPMS-WPMS Partnership's application for a Public Arts Building Communities grant from the DCCAH;

WHEREAS the Cleveland Park Main Street has submitted a grant application on behalf of the CHAW-CPMS-WPMS Partnership for \$5,000 to support the project and has submitted relevant and appropriate information;

WHEREAS Hannah Jacobson Blumenfeld of the Capitol Hill Arts Workshop presented the application at a meeting of the ANC 3C Community Engagement and Grants Committee on 28 February 2023;

WHEREAS many individuals in the community and several community organizations have made pledges to the project, including the Cleveland Park Community Association;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the ANC 3C approves the grant request for \$5,000 provided Cleveland Park

Main Street agrees to comply with all the ANC 3C guidelines with respect to expenditure of funds, maintenance of receipts, and accounting procedures;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC 3C authorizes the Chair and the Treasurer to represent the Commission in this matter.
