WHEREAS Margaret Gorman of Georgetown was named the first “Miss Washington, DC” and was later crowned the inaugural “Miss America 1921”;

WHEREAS the winner of Miss District of Columbia has gone on to become Miss America on two separate occasions (1921 and 1944);

WHEREAS Miss District of Columbia is an active member of the community by serving those in need and advocating for different causes in the District of Columbia;

WHEREAS in 2014, Judith “Jude” Maboné moved to the District of Columbia to attend American University;

WHEREAS Jude Maboné had her first heart attack at the age of 16 and was later diagnosed with heart disease at the age of 17;

WHEREAS While at American University, Jude Maboné was a division I track and cross country athlete and a participant in many different activities on-campus and in the community;

WHEREAS in 2018, Jude Maboné graduated American University in DC with a B.A. in International Studies;

WHEREAS in 2022, Jude Maboné was crowned the inaugural Miss District of Columbia Volunteer- a program that empowers young women by providing them with unique service opportunities in the District of Columbia;

WHEREAS during her time as Miss District of Columbia Volunteer, Jude served alongside many organizations including: Children’s National Hospital and The Honor Flight Network;

WHEREAS Jude started her community service initiative “Check Your Heart” to encourage preemptive heart health measures and CPR and AED awareness;

WHEREAS Jude Maboné is the owner of a Woodley Park-based small business “Old Flame Candle Company”;

WHEREAS Jude Maboné is an active member of the Woodley Park community as well as an active member of the larger District of Columbia;

WHEREAS on June 10, 2023, Jude Maboné of Woodley Park (3C02) was crowned Miss District of Columbia 2023.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED ANC 3C, congratulates Jude Maboné on being crowned the 2023 Miss District of Columbia;
